CAMPO, the federally mandated long range transportation-planning agency for Williamson, Travis and Hays Counties, is about to embark on the update to our existing CAMPO 2025 Transportation Plan. According to federal law, this update must occur at least every five years. Our current plan was adopted in June 2000 and is available on our website: [www.campotexas.org](http://www.campotexas.org).

We are currently developing the CAMPO Mobility 2030 Transportation Plan and would like your organization to be a part of the process. To familiarize you with CAMPO and the 2030 plan development process, we would like to make a presentation to your organization. Your participation is important because it will ensure that the CAMPO Policy Board is aware of your transportation concerns and preferences.

Our timeline calls for staff to present the first draft of the plan to the CAMPO Board on Monday, May 10, 2004. At that time, we will ask the Board to set public hearings on the draft for June 14, 2004 and July 12, 2004. The public hearings will provide an opportunity for you to make comments to the CAMPO Board on the proposed plan and the transportation projects included in the plan. You will also be able to submit written comments on the draft from mid-May until early July. CAMPO's Policy Board will consider the comments as they direct staff to develop a second draft of the plan for a subsequent round of hearings in spring 2005. The Board will then adopt a final version of the plan in March 2005.

We are available to make a presentation to your organization between May 11 and July 2. We will need about 20 minutes for an overview of the draft plan followed by approximately 15-30 minutes for questions and answers. If you are interested in such a presentation, please return the enclosed form by mail or fax, or email or phone us with your preferences. We will then contact you in the next several weeks to make specific arrangements.
