Thank you for the fast reply and I'm in complete agreement to wait until the January 13th meeting.

As for the surveys, I'm not sure if they will be necessary for this proposal because I plan to present a solution that should be amiable to both sides. My proposal will have at least two options:

1. Only renaming the portion of Walnut that begins at Main and extends East.
2. Name the street in honor of Dr. King without removing the actual Walnut street name. This has been done in other cities, where honorarium signs are placed just above the existing street signs signifying designation of the street in Dr. King's honor. This particular option would result in no expense to any of the residents and businesses currently located on Walnut.

It is my desire to pursue the path of least resistance that accomplishes the goal and will of the supporting residents.

The Council agreed to hold only one meeting in December. That meeting will be on December 9th at 6:00 pm.  
The next regular Council meeting will be on January 13th.

For your information, the renaming of the street was on the April 27, 2004 City Council agenda. At that time, the Council had individuals speak against the renaming for various reasons. The Council tabled the introduction of the ordinance at that time and it has not been brought up again.

I have visited with Mayor Hill and he is in support of you presenting this to the Council. We are currently looking for copies of the survey that was conducted along Walnut Street. Mayor Hill wanted the Council to see the support of the residents and businesses surveyed. So far we have not been able to find the surveys. He thought you might want to wait until the January meeting, just in case we cannot find the surveys. If not, another survey might be conducted prior to that meeting.
