Dear Mayor Berger:

In February Governor Perry approved the expansion of the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization planning area boundary to include all of Williamson, Travis and Hays counties. On March 10, the CAMPO Policy Advisory Committee (PAC) approved the formation of a 19-member **CAMPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)** to better coordinate CAMPO's transportation planning process in this new area.

We are requesting that your jurisdiction or agency appoint a **Department Director or Executive Director as member** and **one staff alternate** to the CAMPO Technical Advisory Committee. The membership of the TAC is intended to be composed of directors of departments or agencies with responsibilities related to transportation system planning and/or engineering. A list of the PAC members and the approved TAC member jurisdictions/agencies is attached.

The following is the PAC motion appointing the CAMPO TAC:

"Each jurisdiction should appoint a transportation/planning department head and an alternate for the TAC. The TAC is charged with making recommendations to the PAC on the CAMPO Long Range Plan and Transportation Improvement Program, as well as other related technical issues. The TAC is appointed for one year from this date at which time it will be evaluated by the PAC to review its function and determine if it should continue operation or be modified in some way."

The first meeting of CAMPO's TAC will be on **Friday, April 4 at 9:00 a.m. at the CAMPO offices at 1011 San Jacinto, 3rd floor conference room**. At the meeting, the TAC will be asked to make a recommendation to the PAC on amendments to the CAMPO 2025 Long Range Plan and the 2002 – 2008 Transportation Improvement Program.

We request that the names of your representative and alternate, and contact information, be provided to the CAMPO office by March 21.
